Review of the Season: AGM took place 16 June 1950 in the Lecture Hall.

KUFC played 42 matches in 1st XI League & Cup competitions in clinching the treble of Spartan League (in the first season back) where their only defeats came against third placed Chilwell United FC both home & away, the League Cup in which they comprehensively eliminated the holders Sutton Colliery Welfare FC 10-0 in the 2nd round and the Spartan League Cup with Jimmy Badder netting 75 goals (50 of these before Christmas), Carl Husk 52 and 18 years old winger Jimmy Longworth 18 goals. Carl Husk & Tommy Hinchliffe, both former professionals were fielded under FA licence as 'permit' players. The club were adopted officially by Nottingham Forest FC as a Nursery club. Dennis Foster & Billy Longworth are selected to represent the Spartan League against the Midlands Amateur Alliance representative team on 26 September 1950 which was played to a draw and reserve team centre forward S Roberts scored nine hat-tricks through the duration of the season. Albert Keetley finally made his first XI debut for Bury FC against Birmingham City FC on 20 January 1951. 16 years old centre half Keith Marchbank is selected to represent the District Schools XI. Fred Swanborough set up a KUFC Supporters Club and they were regularly taking two and sometimes three, full bus loads of followers to away matches. JIMMY BADDER's record number of GOALS...49 (League) & 26 (Cup) = 75

FLOURISHING KEYWORTH
RECENTLY adopted by Forest as a nursery club, Keyworth United are following the pattern of City Ground ambitions relating to championship hopes.
 Such hopes were greatly enhanced by the snap-hand win over rivals East Kirkby on Saturday which, giving United a four points lead on two extra matches played, might well have decided the championship. So that Keyworth continue their usual custom of being at the top of the competitions with which they are associated.
 Four years in the Realm League produced a remarkable record, the championship being won three times, the league cup in 1949 and they were the first Realm team to win the Junior Cup—in 1948.
 Of their 20 games to date, 12 have been played away from home, including the drawn match at East Kirkby. So far, Keyworth have scored 160 goals, 108 in the League, 48 in five Intermediate Cup matches, and 24 in the Spartan K.O. Cup.
 Hopkin's is reported his goal very soon.
 has made for a big improvement in the attack, former Work-sop player Carl Husk.
 Centre-forward Jim Badder has already topped the half-century. He is the former Basford Hall star who was on amateur forms with Bolton Wanderers before going into the Army.
 Badder's two goals against East Kirkby brought his total to 51. Husk has got 43 so far and 18-year-old Jimmy Longworth has collected 18, one for each birthday! This youngster played with a broken finger, full-back Peter Gray with a pulled muscle, but he managed to score with the last kick of the match from a yard inside his own half.
 United are in the semi-finals of both trophy competitions, meeting Stapleford Villa in the league cup and, just for the purpose of a local Derby, wondering whether Rudington can get through against Arnold St. Mary's to provide a final involving two neighbouring villages, who have been competing against each other since before this century. Mind you, Stapleford and Arnold have other ideas.
 Forthcoming social events are a joint football and cricket whist drive in the Keyworth Hall on Wednesday, March 21, and a dance at the Astoria on Tuesday, April 3.
